Subject: Collection of E- Waste from the PCC


Accept warm greetings from the Synod Office, Buea. We are happy to inform you that the PCC in partnership with Informatik Fur Afrika will begin a maiden project in Cameroon; ***Recycling Computers in an Environmentally Friendly Manner***. Recycling computers in an Environmentally Friendly Manner is a project which will properly dispose e-waste and reduce its adverse effect on the environment by processing e-waste and retrieving much of the substances inside to avoid the harm caused by disposing such e-waste particles in garbage dumps and landfills, create jobs, improve working conditions and ensure sustainability. This project was designed to be implemented in several phases with the first exclusively for PCC institutions.

For a number of years now, most of our institutions have piled obsolete computers and accessories that need to be recycled and the unrecyclable parts shipped for disposal or proper recycling by the appropriate bodies. We are appealing that you put together obsolete computer equipment in your institution to ease collection. To facilitate the process, we will send one of our technicians with a collection form which should be signed by the head of the institution, the IT Technician/instructor of the institution - where applicable - and the Project IT Technician. The form is hereby attached for the purpose of transparency and accurate statistics for project reporting. No fee will be charged for the collection for PCC Institutions. A collection schedule and collection guidelines will be communicated to you in a subsequent correspondence.

We crave the indulgence of Principals that schools will serve as temporary collection points for all PCC institutions in their environs since most schools have an IT laboratory. Institutions are equally hereby solicited to drop their obsolete computers in the nearest PCC College to ease collection. Your assistance in facilitating the assembling of the e-waste to ease collection would be highly appreciated.
